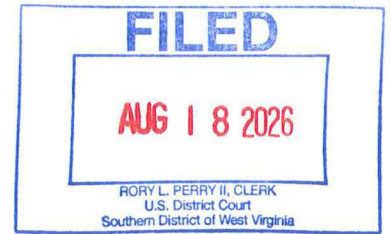

I N D I C T M E N T

The Grand Jury Charges:

From in and around February 2024, to on or about May 18, 2026, at or near Vienna, Wood County, West Virginia, and Williamson, Mingo County, West Virginia, within the Southern District of West Virginia and elsewhere, defendant EDWIN HUGH DOUGLAS, and other persons whose identities are both known and unknown to the Grand Jury, knowingly conspired to commit offenses in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 841(a)(1), that is, knowingly and intentionally distributing 500 grams or more of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine, a Schedule II controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.
